Other Benefit

Other common employment benefits in Georgia include:

- Private healt insurance: Around GEL 100 per month
- Additional paid leave days

Income Tax

Residents

• Flat rate of income tax: 20%

Non-Residents

• Depends on the double taxation agreement between countries. Typically, only income originating in Georgia is taxed, the rate is same as residents



- A tax resident is an individual who meets one of following criteria:
 - Residence in Georgia for at least 183 days in a 12 months period
 - Have their centre of life interests in Georgia

Working Hours

Statutory

40 hours 8 hours a day, 5 days a week **Typical practice** 40 hours Monday - Friday

Overtime

Maximum 8 overtime hours per week

• All overtime: Paid at 150% of the regular hourly rate

Employment Contract

Fixed-Term

Used for specific tasks, seasonal work, temporarily increases workloads and temporarily replacing absent staff

Contract Format	Payroll Currency	Probation	Contract Period
Can be oral or written in Georgian. bilingual. Contracts over 1 month must be in writing and sent to staff within 14 working days after onboarding. Possible use of electronic signature.	GEL	Maximum 6 months	Up to 30 months including renewals
